





## PREPAREDNESS FOR CYCLONE "PHANI"

### ADVISORY NOTE/ INSTRUCTIONS


Order No. 82 / Date: 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2019

01	ITEMS	ACTION TO BE TAKEN
1	Attendance	All the employees are not allowed to avail any nature of Leave until further order. All the holidays are cancelled.
2	Trimming of tree branches	All the fragile branches of the trees outside animal enclosures shall be inspected by Spl.Project Range assisted by Sri Shibaram Sahoo. Similarly, the trees inside the enclosure shall be inspected by Sanctuary management Range and wherever necessary, steps should be taken immediately to trim the branches. Power chainsaw should be kept ready trimming the branches during and before onset of cyclone.
3	Storage of Diesel/ Kerosene/ Petrol etc	All the Range within their jurisdiction should arrange sufficient quantity of petrol/ diesel/ kerosene to be kept in the stock.
4	Alternate power sources	All the alternate power supply should be made functional by 2 <sup>nd</sup> of May, 2019.
5	Organisation	Sri Amulya Ku.Parida, ACF, Visitor Management shall be Chief Coordinating Officer for the purpose. All the officers i/c. of ranges shall act as per the instruction of Chief Coordinating Officer.
6	Animal Enclosure	No animals shall be allowed to stay in display & back kraal during cyclone as per the practicability.
7	Equipments	Search light, torchlight, Inverter battery must be verified prior to cyclone and it should be repaired if necessary.
8	Clearance of debris	The vehicles under the charge of Store Range shall be engaged in clearance of debris and twigs/ trees branches immediately after cyclone to make the visitor path free from debris.
9	Vehicle arrangement	One Bolero vehicle shall be hired for the days during cyclone which will be under control of Chief Coordinating Officer and be utilized as & when required depending upon the situation. Other existing vehicles shall be utilized for the respective usual functions. One similar vehicle along with one tractor with trolley will also be hired for the SBG under the control of ACF, SBG to be utilized during the cyclone.
10	Trimming of tree branches in SBG	The branches of the trees likely to be damaged to any infrastructures within SBG shall be removed/ trimmed immediately before the cyclone.
11	Health care & treatment	Sufficient quantity of Medicines both for animals and visitors shall be kept reserved in the zoo hospital for precautionary steps against trauma.


